
Holiday Break Hours

Speech Concerns

"How do I know if my child needs speech?" If you have concerns about your child's speech, you can start by talking to his or her teacher. As a general rule for 3 year olds, you should be able to understand about 80% of speech, they should be able to follow 2 step directions, can take turns (with encouragement). As a general rule for 4 year olds, you should be able to understand 95% of speech, they should be able to sing familiar songs, and engage in play with others. We strongly encourage you to have your child tested if you are concerned about their speech. Speech concerns addressed early are corrected faster and have less long-term effects on learning and frustration in social situations. Screenings are free and can be arranged through Hilton School District for children three and four years old. Children under three are evaluated by Monroe County Early Intervention.
