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#### **Payment reminders:**

As a reminder, all accounts, daycare or preschool, must be paid in advance according to your tuition schedule. Daycare families' tuition will be due the Friday prior to the week of care. Preschool families' tuition will be due the first of the month. Invoices will be sent to your email the week prior so payments can be made online.

A late fee of \$20 will be added to your account if payments are not received prior to the end of the week or by the  $5^{\text{th}}$  of the month they are due. Accounts that miss two consecutive payments will be need to be paid in full before children are able to return to our program. If an account becomes habitually behind, a deposit of an additional week will be required. Cash, check, credit card, or flexible spending account payments will still be accepted in the office.

## **September Teaching Units**

**2 year olds will learn about transportation.** This month we will read about cars, trucks, boats, trains and planes. We will make pictures and make boxes into vehicles. We will also learn songs about buses and boats. Be sure to check our calendar and bring a riding toy the week of the 16th.

**3 year olds will study water and air.** In the morning we will blow bubbles, explore pond life, make water animals, count and learn about letters A and B. We will make a boat and explore sinking and floating. We have added an afternoon Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday class with the same curriculum and teacher. Spaces are still available, if you or anyone you know would be interested in the afternoon class.

**UPK/4 year olds will learn about insects and transportation this month.** For our insects unit we will learn about the letters A –ants, B - bees and beetles and C - cars, as well as make spider webs (not really insects at all!), and learn how insects change. We will learn many fun songs this month. We will begin our math and science units as we get to know each other. Spaces are still available in this class.

**School Age Wrap Care will be focusing on STEM activities this month.** In the mornings we will start our day with a light breakfast, brain teasers, coloring pages, and other activities to get us ready and focused for the day. In the afternoon we will have homework time and then an activity to go along with our theme for the month/week. Our weekly themes include Architecture, Mechanics, Electricity, and Properties of Liquids. We will be building A LOT of neat things and performing some fun experiments.



We will be selling Mums from DeConinck Farms starting September 18<sup>th</sup> until they're gone. So be sure to get them while they last! They are selling for \$7.50 each or 3 for \$21 or 5 for \$32.

We will remove and put lunches on plates when lunches are in bags.
